When does team registration take place?

Registration for the MSCR Fall Basketball Program will be held:

Tues., September 28 from 8am–6pm and Wed., September 29 (if space remains) from 8am-4pm at the MSCR Office, 3802 Regent St. – sorry no on-line registration, however anyone may register the team. REGISTRATION FOR FALL ADULT BASKETBALL IS FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE – please note:

5 on 5 leagues - 30 men's teams and 6 women's teams will be accepted for ***play on Tuesday or Wednesday evenings***. At the time of registration, teams must have 7 signed player contracts and the team fee of \$300 is due (no exceptions).

NEW in 2010 - 3 on 3 leagues - 18 men's teams and 6 women's teams will be accepted into the 3 on 3 leagues for ***play on Monday evenings***. At the time of registration, teams must have 4 signed player contracts and the team fee of \$200 is due (no exceptions).

Question: What are the fees involved to register a team?

	Team Fee	Min. # of players	
<i>5 on 5 league</i> 5 week season	\$ 300	7	Two officials, one scorekeeper, site supervisor, 5 (one hour, approx.) games
<i>3 on 3 league</i> 5 week season	\$200	4	One court supervisor, 10 (30 minute, approx.) games, over 5 weeks.

The team fee is the total fee for a team to play fall basketball. The fee no longer consists of a team fee & player fee. ***A player contract card must be filled out by each member of the team.*** The team fee covers all players (no limit) registered on a team.

I am new to the area and would like to join a team. Do you know of teams that are in need of players?

Teams in the MSCR program are formed by individuals, not by MSCR. However, we compile a “player pool” of players looking to join a team and make the list available to managers who are looking to add players to their team. If you would like to be placed on this pool, simply go on-line to our website at www.msqr.org and fill out and submit the Player Referral Form, from the Adult Sports League menu. Your name will be added to the pool. There is no fee involved until you join a team. MSCR can not guarantee that you will be placed on a team. If you would like to organize a team of your own, consider using the Player Referral Pool to identify interested players!

Question: Who are the leagues for?

Leagues are for men and women ages 18 and older who are Madison Metropolitan School District residents. 50% of your roster may be nonresidents of the Madison Metropolitan School District. Question: When will schedules be available for teams?

League schedules for the Tuesday and Wednesday 5 on 5 leagues will be mailed out to team managers the week of October 4, 2010. League schedules for the Monday *3 on 3 leagues* will be mailed to team managers the week of October 11, 2010. League schedules will also be posted at www.msqr.org.

Question: Can I play on more than one team?

People may play on multiple teams as long as they only play on one team per night. They must have a player contract signed for each team they play on. They cannot sub on Team A, even for one game, without a contract for Team A, even though they have a contract for Team B.

Question: Where are games played?

FALL BASKETBALL SITES – Registration is first come, first served (*register early!*)

Tuesday leagues:

October 12 – November 16

18 men’s teams, 6 women’s teams

5 on 5 leagues

East High School Fieldhouse

2222 E. Washington Ave., 53704

Park in large lot off 4th St. Go up steps between fieldhouse & school. Enter door #4 and go up steps on your left; follow entire length of hall in front of trophy case to the new Fieldhouse entryway (to the left), just down the stairs and beyond the boys locker room entrance.

Wednesday leagues:

October 13 – November 17

5 on 5 leagues

*Limit 6 men’s teams at each site

Toki Middle School, 5606 Russett Rd., 53711

Park in lot off Whitney Way. Use 4-door glass entryway closest to playfield, take hallway to the right; Gym is on the left.

or

Sennett Middle School, 502 Pflaum Rd., 53716

Park in large lot behind school, enter the row of glass doors and turn right to enter the gym.

Monday leagues:

October 25 – November 22

3 on 3 leagues

Limit 12 men’s teams at Olson

Olson Elementary School, 801 Redan Dr., Verona, 53593

Enter small parking lot off Redan Dr in front of school, or Enter Parking lot off Ancient Oak Lane, walk around to front entrance of school and enter door #1.

or

Limit 6 men’s & 6 women’s teams at Allis

Allis Elementary School, 4201 Buckeye Rd., 53716.

Enter off Jerome St. Go through gate to park behind the school. Enter double doors to the gym.
