

WHAT IS MSCR'S SAFE HAVEN PROGRAM?

As a part of the Madison Metropolitan School District, MSCR's Safe Haven has provided quality childcare since 1992. Safe Haven was established with the belief that all children need a safe and enriching place to spend their after school hours, while their parents are at work or school.



AT SAFE HAVEN WE:

- Provide youth with activities and skills that enhance physical and cognitive capabilities, and build self esteem
- Teach youth alternative ways to solve conflict
- Build teamwork and cooperation skills

STAFFING

MSCR makes every effort to hire diverse, qualified, caring and professional staff who have experience, education, and a desire to work with youth in a recreation setting. All employees have passed a background check through the Wisconsin Department of Justice and a TB test. We take pride in the quality of our staff and maintain high standards by training staff in a variety of topics including: CPR, behavior management (Above the Line), supervision, health and safety, age appropriate practices and other related topics. MSCR provides a 10:1 child to staff ratio.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

MSCR Safe Haven programs always needs volunteers who can help with homework, lead activities, share skills, read stories, go on fieldtrips, and teach enrichment clubs. 2011-12 SCHOOL YEAR SAFE HAVEN FEES

Monthly fees for the Safe Haven after-school program are:

- ▶ \$315 for one child
- ▶ \$550 for 2 children from the same immediate family
- ▶ \$785 for 3 or more children from the same immediate family

MSCR accepts Dane County Childcare Assistance for families who qualify. For information contact Vicki at 204-6561. If you do not qualify for Dane County Childcare Assistance and are unable to pay full fees, you must apply for a partial fee waiver and submit the required financial documents. Payments will be determined by a sliding fee scale.

2011 SUMMER SAFE HAVEN PROGRAMS

Summer programs will operate eight weeks from June 20 – August 12, Monday through Friday except for July 4th. Activities include art, science, sports, free play time, structured games, and field trips. Fees for the 2011 eight-week Safe Haven summer program are:

- ▶ \$999 for one child
- ▶ \$1,749 for 2 children from the same immediate family
- ▶ \$2,499 for 3 or more children from the same immediate family

MSCR accepts Dane County Childcare Assistance and provides partial fee waivers for the summer Safe Haven program just as we do during the school-year. Please see the paragraph above under school year for more information on how to apply.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is available following the Safe Haven program from the following program locations: Allis, Glendale, Hawthorne, Lincoln and Midvale. Transportation is only available for those children who are bussed to their school for the regular school day.

EARLY-RELEASE & NO-SCHOOL DAYS

MSCR Safe Haven programs will operate on scheduled early-release days. All day programming on no-school days (including teacher in-services and parent-teacher conferences) will be available at certain locations for an additional fee (pre-registration is required). However, Safe Haven will not operate on holidays, during winter or spring break or when school is closed due to weather.

RELEASE OF CHILDREN

Only authorized persons specified on the child's release form may pick up a child.

VISITORS AND OBSERVATIONS

Parent/Guardians are welcome to visit and observe the MSCR Safe Haven programs any time. For liability and supervision reasons visiting children may not participate in MSCR Safe Haven programs. Community members who wish to observe the program must request permission from the Site Supervisor and/or the MSCR CLC Supervisor.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

School-based Safe Haven programs are open to all children attending the school in which the program is held. Neighborhood center-based programs are open to all children living in the areas surrounding the neighborhood center.

TO REGISTER

Registration materials are available in your school's office or by contacting your program's site director. Registrations must be completed in full to be eligible for the Safe Haven programs. All incomplete forms will be returned without processing.
